

# What is the Self-Study Design?


The *Self-Study Design* provides the framework for the Self-Study process:


- Its organizational structure

## SSD Working Groups: General Charges

- 1. Reading and viewing resources provided by MSCHE, VPAA, and Steering Committee.
- 2. Identifying relevant policies, procedures, and structures relevant to assessing each standard.
- 3. Analyzing relevant documents and processes to assess how each corresponds to verifying that standards are met.
- 4. Demonstrating periodic assessment of policies, evidences, and processes inherent in each standard.
- 5. Crafting opportunities for improvement based on findings and analysis.

institutions earn accredited status, and this permits them to state with confidence: "Our students are well-served; society is well-served."




