PRDE Standards and Expectations and Curricular Maps are based on college and career-ready-standards

The Puerto Rico Core Standards (2014) were developed by the Puerto Rico Department of Education as college and career ready standards. That standards are divided into five distinct standards: Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing and Language. Each standard consists of both College and Career Readiness (CCR) expectations and grade level indicators. The CCR expectations and grade-specific indicators are necessary complements. The former provides broad expectations, the latter provides additional specificity that together defines the skills and competencies that all students must master.
